Report on celebration of Teacher's Day

Teacher's Day was celebrated on 5th September 2020. The alumni faculty of our college arranged this celebration for senior faculty. Prof K.B Vasudeva, Director of Legal Studies was invited as Chief Guest, Smt Deepu.P, Principal, Presided the occasion.

Prof K.B Vasudeva addressing the faculty group present spoke about the contributions of alumni students of our college. He appreciated the interest of alumni faculty in organizing this function in absence of student group. Speaking on importance of celebrating teacher's day he said the day is dedicated to teachers and acknowledges their contribution in shaping one's life. The day is celebrated to mark the birth day of Dr. Radhakrishnan who was a staunch believer of education and was a well-known diplomat, scholar, the president of India and above all a teacher. He believed that the study of Indian philosophy and its interpretation in western terms would cast off the imperial inferiority complex and give Indians a renewed sense of self-esteem. Advocate Nagraj M, Alumni student and Visiting faculty of our college addressed the faculty and shared his experience of being a student at VVLC. He said the importance of teacher lies in how well he molds his student's mind to face life. Today, the legal profession is growing and the law teachers contribute a lot in shaping a good advocate for society. Every year over fifteen thousand students enroll as advocates in bar council. Very few get success in profession. It all depends upon the interest and learning in a law college. He too appreciated the work of alumni faculty present and praised their contribution to the institution. He remembered each one of them as his student and said that our college is the only law college that has marked the teacher's teacher relationship from generation to generation. He thanked the faculty for organizing this celebration.

Advocate AP Nagendra Gupta addressing the faculty group thanked the support offered by the institution and our Director Prof K.B Vasudeva. He recalled his memory in late 90s when he began his teaching profession at Vidyavardhaka evening college. He pointed that very less number of students opts for practicing law and so there is shortage of juniors at local courts.
