The following scholarship details explained by the resource person

1.	Pre-Matric Scholarship for Minorities of Karnataka	August to September	The scholarship covers tuition fee, admission fee and maintenance allowance
2.	Post-Matric Scholarship for Minorities of Karnataka	August to September	The scholarship covers tuition fee, admission fee and maintenance allowance
3.	Merit-Cum-Means Scholarship for Minorities, Karnataka	August to September	Scholarship up to INR 30,000
4.	National Overseas Scholarship for Minority Community Students, Karnataka	May to July	Scholarship up to INR 20 Lakh per ann up to 2 years covering the cost of course, living expenses and one side airfare
5.	Incentive for SSLC & 2nd PUC Students, Karnataka	August to September	One-time incentive of INR 10,000 to SS students and INR 20,000 to 2 nd PUC
