

WORLD WATER DAY

On 22nd March 2019 'World Water Day' was celebrated. Sri KVR Choudhry, in charge Senior Geologist, Geographer, District Ground Water Office, Mysore spoke on 'Importance of Ground Water in Mysore District'. In 1993, the United Nations General Assembly officially designated March 22 as World Water Day. World Water Day is coordinated by UN-Water in collaboration with governments and partners. World Water Day is about taking action to tackle the water crisis. Today, there are over 663 million people living without a safe water supply close to home, spending countless hours queuing or trekking to distant sources, and coping with the health impacts of using contaminated water. He mentioned that contaminated groundwater is very difficult and expensive to clean up. Solutions can be found after groundwater has been contaminated but this isn't always easy. The best thing to do is adopt pollution prevention and conservation practices in order to protect important groundwater supplies from being contaminated or depleted in the first place.
