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REPORT OF INAUGURATION OF ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES 2022-23 HELD ON DEC 10^{TH} 2022

The Students Council of our college organized Inauguration of Academic Activities 2022-23 on Dec 10th 2022 at Prof. P.M. Chikkaboraiah Seminar Hall. Dr. Deepu.P, Principal welcomed everyone. Prof. Vasudeva. K.B, Director of Legal Studies, introduced the guests. This programme was presided over by Sri. Gundappa Gowda, Hon'ble President, Vidyavardhaka Sangha, Mysuru.





This programme has been inaugurated by Hon'ble Mr. Justice T.G. Shivashankare Gowda, Judge, High Court of Karnataka. In their inaugural address the Judge inspired the students while explaining their professional experience as advocate, as magistrate, as district judge and as registrar of High Court and as well as Judge of High Court. They said that, they came to legal profession from rural poor family and even there is no scope for traditional degree courses in front of medical, engineering courses which have great significance at that time, and joined Law degree. While studying the law, they learned English without fear with a great inclination. After the degree, became successful advocate and also become judge of

High Court. Student from the rural background and from Kannada medium should not have any fear about language. They should learn law not in the examination point but law as whole. Almost famous advocates, judges are from Kannada Medium and rural areas and they are earning more in legal profession than engineering and medical profession. Thus the degree holders of engineering and medical are joining law courses and hence now days more law colleges have been establishing to impart legal education. Further, in their though provoking speech, they expressed the importance of advocacy, legal profession and practice. Legal profession is social service and not mere money making profession. Advocates should have concern towards members of the society especially poor and weaker sections. In their speech they explained various civil and criminal cases as illustrations as they experienced as advocates and as judge. And they informed students opportunity in legal sector as Magistrate, judge, company or corporate legal advisor, tax matters practitioner etc., and so far they influenced more than 80 advocate practitioners to become judicial officer in the state and invited our students to join wonderful judicial service with few years of practiced experience. The speech of Judge was meaningful, intellectual, thought provoking.

Sri Gundappa Gowda, Hon'ble president of Vidyavardhaka Sangha, has rendered presidential Speech and Er Vishwanath, Hon'ble Secretary, and Sri. Shreeshyla Ramannavar, Hon'ble Treasurer of Vidyavardhaka Sangha (R) Mysuru graced the occasion. The programme was meaningful.
