





On 25th January 2022 at 3.00PM programme on "National Voter's Day" was organised. Theme of the voter's day of 2022 is 'Making Elections Inclusive, Accessible and Participative. In this programme Prof. K.B Vasudeva, Director of Legal Studies explained importance of National Voter's Day. Since 2011, National Voters' Day has been celebrated on January 25 every year, all across the country to mark the foundation day of the Election Commission of India, i.e. 25th January 1950. The main purpose of the NVD celebration is to create electoral awareness amongst citizens and encourage them to participate in the electoral process.
