REPORT ON CELEBRATION OF NATIONAL CONSUMER'S DAY (2022-23)

National Consumers Day was celebrated at Vidyavardhaka Law College on 31st December 2022.

Sri B.Narayanappa, President, District Consumer Dispute Redressal Commission inaugurated the occasion and spoke on the objectives of the Consumer Protection Act as amended in the year 2019. He said that today the application of the act is wider in scope. It is applicable to sectors like banking, insurance, real estate, transportation and consumer service providers. The inclusion of product liability under the new act has brought a tremendous change in the idea of consumer protection. Under this it is the responsibility of manufacturer of product seller or service provider to compensate for any harm caused to a consumer for selling defective product or for deficiency in service. The act has set up Consumer Dispute Redressal Commission which today aims to resolve dispute through Lok Adalats. The Mysore District Consumer Dispute Redressal Commission has successfully solved about 94% of the consumer disputes ever since its establishment and has continuously worked towards protection of consumers in Mysore District. Concluding his speech he said consumers too should be 'consumer friendly' as even they have a duty to protect our environment. This concern should be shown while they purchasing the products which are environmental friendly.

Chief Guest of this occasion Dr. Bhamy V Shenoy, Founder of Mysuru Grahakara Parishat speaking in this occasion said that the consumer commission formed under the act has been working like a civil court. The commission should aim to protect the interest of consumers by creating awareness about their rights. Here it is not only the duty to government or any statutory authority but it is the duty of every consumer to be aware about their rights. They should come forward to protect their own rights thereby utilizing the facility given by the legislation.
