Sheshadri Iyer Road- Mysuru-01 REPORT ON CELEBRATION OF PARAKRAM DIVAS ON THE OCCASION OF 125TH BIRTH ANNIVERSARY OF NETHAJI SUBHASH CHANDRA BOSE

On 5th January 2022 at 1.00PM on the occasion of 125th birth anniversary of Nethaji Subhash Chandra bose "Prakram Divas was celebrated. In this occasion Principal Dr. Deepu P welcomed the resource person and gatherings. Smt. Suma, Secretary AIDYO, Mysuru District and Nithushree were the guest speakers.



The Speaker pointed out that, the central government has decided to observe Subhas Chandra Bose Jayanti as 'Parakram Diwas' to be celebrated on 23rd January. A high-level committee headed by the Prime Minister has also been formed to plan year-round programmes to mark the anniversary of Bose. Recently the Government of India has also instituted Subhash Chandra Bose Aapda Prabandhan Puraskaar to recognise the excellent work done by the individuals and institutions in the field of disaster management. Speaker explained various role played by Subhash Chandra Bose like

- He stood for unqualified swaraj (independence), and opposed Motilal Nehru Report which spoke for dominion status for India.
- He actively participated in the Salt Satyagraha of 1930 and vehemently opposed the suspension of Civil Disobedience Movement and signing of the Gandhi-Irwin Pact in 1931.

- In the 1930s, he was closely associated with left politics in Congress along with Jawaharlal Nehru and M.N. Roy.
- Bose won the congress presidential elections at Haripura in 1938.
- Again in 1939 at Tripuri, he won the presidential elections against Gandhi's candidate Pattabhi Sitarammayya. Due to ideological differences with Gandhi, Bose resigned and left congress. Rajendra Prasad was appointed in his place.
- He found a new party, 'the Forward Bloc'. The purpose was to consolidate the political left and major support base in his home state Bengal.



Another speaker highlighted about All India Democratic Youth Organisation (AIDYO) with the stated purpose of uniting the youth of India to fight all social menaces and atrocities such as superstition, communalism, casteism, regionalism, religious fundamentalism, etc. The organisation encourages the youth to observe the birth and death anniversaries of the great men of history who fought for secular democratic and revolutionary ideology in their time which is of social relevance even now.





Finally the programme concluded with vote of thanks by the coordinator Sri H.C. Ningegowda. This programme was witnessed by Prof K.B Vasudeva, Director of Legal Studies, Faculties and I & II LL.B (3Yrs) students.
